

Graduation Rates (Student Right-to-Know Act)

Some students take longer than 150% of normal time (three years for an associate degree or six years for a bachelors), to graduate for a variety of reasons. Those who graduate, but take longer than six years are considered below as not completed. Others come to Calvary with the intent to attend only one, or two years, gain a biblical education, and then complete their bachelor's degree at another institution.
