
### **Alumni Survey Report**

#### 2020-2021


The Alumni survey was sent through Survey Monkey in June 2021 with 17 questions. The survey went to 128 alums who graduated between the years 2016-2020 with only 21 responses making the response rate 16.4%. The results of this survey are shown below.

Student alums attended Calvary ranging from 2-11 years. Over 52% of the students lived on- campus much of their time while attending Calvary as shown in the graph below:








